

Jim,

Someone opened the No Name Weir yesterday and there seems to be some turbid water flowing from the inside of the canal out of the weir into the "Big Lake". We were told the weir would be closed until the remediation was completed, not sure what happened.... I do not think this is sediment but turbidity due to the velocity of the water coming from the weir, but we should take precautions and will continue to monitor. The attached drone shots are from Providence's EI. He will fly the drone everyday going forward. Our drone is down for repairs and that team has other obligations onsite.

I have instructed **Callan** to expedite the turbidity curtain at the weir due the premature opening.

Mon, Aug 18, 2025

Summary:

The discussion focused on sediment management and ongoing projects within the Cameron Parish Port, Harbor, and Terminal District. Kim Montie raised concerns about sediment entering through compromised gates in the weir, prompting an investigation by a team from the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority, including Ivy Thibodeaux and Philip Parker. The installation of a curtain by Callan Dredge Company along the North Lake Rim Conveyance Channel was highlighted as a measure to mitigate sediment movement. The group engaged in collaborative discussions to clarify the situation, with Ivy explaining the potential issues related to slots in the gate structure that may contribute to sediment leakage.

Chuck, Jamie and I just met up with Joby and flagged all of the crab pots that are buried with BLUE survey tape. All pots east of the sediment curtain should now be tagged and verbally permitted to remove. Sandra, attached is the LA R.S. Regarding Crab Traps (Section E).

Please let me know how you prefer we receive permission from Joby for Callan Marine staff to remove these traps as they dredge as I assume verbal permission is not adequate. These cannot be pulled prior to dredging, so it will be removal as they reach them. My understanding is that dredging could start as early as tomorrow.

Joby is pulling all other pots on the west side of sediment curtain (some partially buried). If he is unable to get them up, he will let me know and we will flag them with Blue tape as well.
